Article 1:

To consider 2019 Payloader purchase

The board discussed the warranty information provided by Frank Martin and Sons and Nortrax. Nortrax offers a longer warranty for the same price.

Motion by Christy to accept the bid for the John Deere Nortrax payloader

Article 2:

To consider FY 2020 Mil Rate

Based on the FY 2020 expense and revenue budget, Aubrie presented the board with the mil rate options generated by Trio.

Christy motioned to take \$25,000 out of surplus for various projects to offset a large increase in mil rate and to set the mil rate at 19

Article 4:

To consider Town credit card limit increase

Aubrie explained that due to multiple Summerfest purchases made online with immediate payment due, that the card limit has been exceeded. The Board requested that Aubrie make payments from the Summerfest checking account to the credit card

and hold the limit where it was originally at \$5,000

To consider paving bids

Motion by Christy to accept the Pelletier Ford bid for the regular cab pickup and v plow, at \$38,139 and to put old pick up out to bid with plow

Second by Dave

The Town Manager inquired as to what the board feels the Public Works Foreman should be paid for time spent doing sewer work in the time it will take to hire for the position.

Motion by Christy to pay John at the rate of \$27.50/hour and to prorate the time he's already put in since July 5

Second by Dave
